1. INTRODUCTION

The City of Seneca, South Carolina ("City") invites qualified Design-Build firms to submit sealed proposals for the design and construction of six (6) pickleball courts, including an asphalt access drive and parking lot.

The selected Design-Build firm will be responsible for comprehensive services, including project design, permitting, and full construction delivery. The City seeks a single point of responsibility for both design and construction to ensure cost control, schedule adherence, and high-quality workmanship.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

A. Design Services

- i. Provide complete site design, civil engineering, grading/drainage, and utility coordination.
- ii. Prepare construction documents, specifications, and stamped drawings in compliance with all applicable codes.
- iii. Secure all necessary permits and approvals from the City and other relevant authorities.
- iv. Develop a final design in collaboration with City staff to ensure compliance with USA Pickleball standards and community expectations.

B. Construction Services

- i. Site Preparation
 - a) Demolition and removal of existing tennis court surface.
 - b) Proper disposal of all debris in accordance with Oconee County landfill regulations.
 - c) Site grading and stabilization to ensure proper drainage.

ii. Pickleball Courts (6 Total)

- a) Court layout per USAPA standards (20' x 44' playing area with 10' clear zones).
- b) Post-tension concrete or asphalt base with professional acrylic surfacing system.
- c) Two-tone acrylic color coating system, per City approval.
- d) Permanent pickleball line striping with regulation white textured paint.
- e) Heavy-duty net and post systems, center straps.
- f) 10' black vinyl-coated chain link fencing with lockable gates.

iii. Access and Drive Parking Lots

- a) Asphalt access drive from nearest public ROW (E. Perkins Creek Rd).
- b) Parking lot with minimum 30 spaces, with 2 ADA spaces.
- c) 2" asphalt surface course over 4" compacted aggregate base.
- d) Concrete curb & gutter.
- e) ADA-compliant striping and signage.
- f) Drainage and stormwater improvements as needed/required.
- g) ADA-compliant sidewalk access to courts.



iv. Landscaping and Finishing

- a) Site restoration with sod/seed and straw.
- b) Limited landscaping (shrubs) as approved by City.

C. Site Examination

All prospective interested firms are required to visit and examine the project site prior to submitting a proposal (see **Appendix C** for project site location). By submitting a proposal, the bidder affirms that:

- i. They have personally inspected the site and its surroundings.
- ii. They are familiar with all existing conditions, including access, utilities, drainage, grading, and any other variables that may affect the work.
- iii. Their proposal accounts for all such conditions, whether apparent or reasonably discoverable during a site visit.
- iv. They will not be entitled to additional compensation for conditions that could have been identified during a proper site examination.

A **Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit** will be held on **Friday, September 26 at 10:00 AM EST** at the project location. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Meeting is strongly encouraged but not mandatory.

- Firms that attend the scheduled Pre-Bid Meeting will have their site visit recorded by City staff
- Firms that do not attend the scheduled Pre-Bid Meeting are still required to independently visit the site and must explicitly state in their proposal that they conducted a site visit, including the date and time of their visit.
- Failure to comply with this requirement will render a proposal non-responsive.

3. PROPOSAL SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ii. Design-Build Team Qualifications Demonstrated experience in both design and construction of athletic/recreational facilities.
- iii. Project Understanding & Approach Narrative describing design process, quality control, and construction methodology.
- iv. Conceptual Design Preliminary layout/site plan (schematic level).
- v. References Three (3) Design-Build projects of similar scope in the last five years.
- vi. Cost Proposal Lump sum fee with breakdown for design, construction, and any recommended alternates.
- vii. Schedule Preliminary design and construction timeline.
- viii. All proposals must include a completed *Proposal Price Form* (Appendix A).
- ix. Required Forms See Appendix B Required Forms Checklist.

4. PROPOSAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

- i. Experience & qualifications 20%
- ii. Overall design and project schedule 20%



- iii. Cost proposal (Appendix A) 50%
- iv. References & past performance 10%

The City of Seneca (the City) intends to select and retain a contractor whose response to this Request for Proposals best demonstrates ability to perform and comply with requirements herein. Requirements are not intended to be restrictive but indicate minimum requirements necessary. The City will determine if minor deviations are acceptable. All work will be performed in accordance with applicable local, state and federal requirements. Unless stated otherwise herein, the basic and governing language of any contract resulting from this solicitation shall be comprised of the RFP documents, including any attachments and Addendums, and a signed Bid Form (pages 1 & 2 of this RFP). The City anticipates that it will award a contract in a timely manner. All respondents shall be notified in writing of the final selection via a Notice of Award posted to the City's website. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any, all or any part of offers received as a result of this request, to waive any informalities or to cancel in part or in its entirety this request, if it is in the best interest to do so. The City will be sole judge as to whether proposals submitted meet all requirements. This solicitation does not commit the City to award a contract, to pay any cost incurred in the preparation of proposals or to procure or contract for goods and services.

5. BID BOND

A Bid Bond or certified check payable to the City of Seneca, SC in the amount of five (5) percent of the Bid sum must accompany the proposal. Security shall be either certified check or bid bond issued by surety licensed to conduct business in the State of South Carolina.

The successful bidder's security will be retained until it has executed a Contract and furnished the required payment and performance bonds

6. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BOND REQUIREMENT

The selected firm shall furnish both a Performance Bond and a Labor & Material Payment Bond equal to 100% of the contract amount within 10 days of receiving a fully executed contract.

7. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- i. The City reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and waive any technicalities or informalities.
- ii. No proposal may be withdrawn within sixty (60) days of the opening date.
- All design and construction must comply with City of Seneca codes, SCDOT standards, ADA requirements, and USA Pickleball specifications.
- iv. Contractor must carry required insurance and secure all permits.
- v. The Agency and any Subcontractor shall promptly pay all federal, state, and local taxes which may be assessed against him in connection with the work or his operations under the Agreement and/or the other contract documents, including, but not limited to, taxes attributable to the purchase of materials and equipment, to the performance of services, and the employment of persons in the prosecution of the work.
- vi. The selected Agency and all Subcontractors will each be required to obtain a City of Seneca Business License.



8. GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

This insurance to be in the comprehensive form, shall protect the Agency, <u>and shall be written to include the City of Seneca</u>, <u>SC</u> against any/all claims arising from injuries to the public, or damage to property of others arising out of any act or omission of the Agency, its agents, employees or subcontractors.

An original certificate of insurance, indicating that the awarded Agency has coverage in accordance with the requirements of this section, shall be furnished by the Agency to the City within five (5) working days of such request and must be received and accepted by the City prior to contract execution and/or before any work begins.

The Agency shall carry comprehensive general liability insurance with limits of liability not

less than: Bodily Injury: \$1,000,000.00 - Each Person

Property Damage: \$1,000,000.00 - Each Accident

The liability coverage under this policy shall contain no exclusion relative to blasting, explosive, collapse of buildings or damage to underground property. Liability limits under this policy shall be not less than the following:

9. WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE

The Agency and all Subcontractors shall carry Workman's Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance with the statutory limits applying to employer's liability (\$100,000.00) covering all employees employed by him or City approved subcontractors while engaged under this Contract. A Certificate shall be provided to the City as proof of coverage.

11. SUBMITTAL

One hard copy of the proposal is due in the Office of the City Administrator no later than **Friday**, **October 10**, **2025** at **2:00 PM EST**. Proposals must be submitted in a sealed envelope and marked "**Design & Construction of six (6) Pickleball Courts and Parking Lot**".

Late Submittals

Under no circumstances shall proposals be accepted after the specified deadline. The City will not be responsible for late deliveries or delayed mail. It is the Agency's sole responsibility to ensure that submittals are complete and delivered prior to the stated deadline. Oral offers or offers by facsimile or email are not acceptable.
