**CITY OF SENECA LAUNCHES
LEGACY BRICK PROGRAM
TO BENEFIT DOG PARK**

SENECA, SC November 15, 2022 – City of Seneca officials launched its new Legacy Brick program today to benefit the upcoming City of Seneca PetSafe Dog Park. The Legacy Brick Program is an ongoing fundraising program which will generate implementation and maintenance funds for the new dog park. Goals are for the dog park to be predominantly funded with money other than local tax-payer dollars.

The program will allow individuals or businesses to purchase an engraved brick paver which will become a permanent part of the sidewalk and entrance to the dog park. The brick paver with engraving can be purchased “in honor of” or “in memory of” of a pet, a family member or friend, or just a business or individual’s name. The paver represents an ideal way for dog park enthusiasts to show support for the park while at the same time leaving a lasting reflection of their gift.

The brick pavers are 4” x 8” and may be inscribed with a maximum of 20 characters per line, 3 lines maximum, including spaces and punctuation. The brick pavers are \$100 each and there is no limit to the number of bricks that can be purchased.

The brick pavers can now be purchased online at the city’s website: www.seneca.sc.us or by sending in a hard copy of the purchase form with a check to Seneca City Hall to the attention of Debbie Williams. Those forms are available at City Hall.

Construction on the City of Seneca PetSafe Dog Park is scheduled to begin early in 2023 with an opening date in the summer of 2023. The park will be located on the corner of Doug Berry Drive and Quincy Road and will be a part of the Bennie Cunningham Jr. Park.
