
Seneca Light & Water contractors are trained in the selection and application of safe and environmentally safe products that promote both wildlife and a reliable electric service.

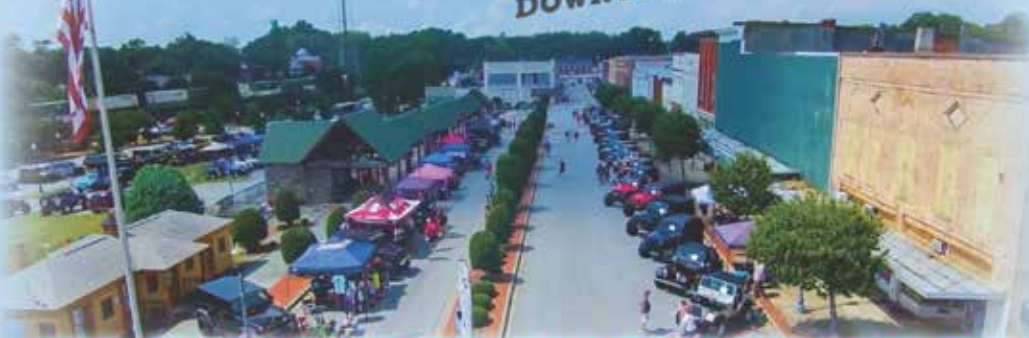
