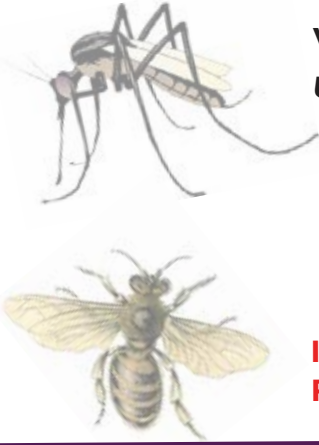

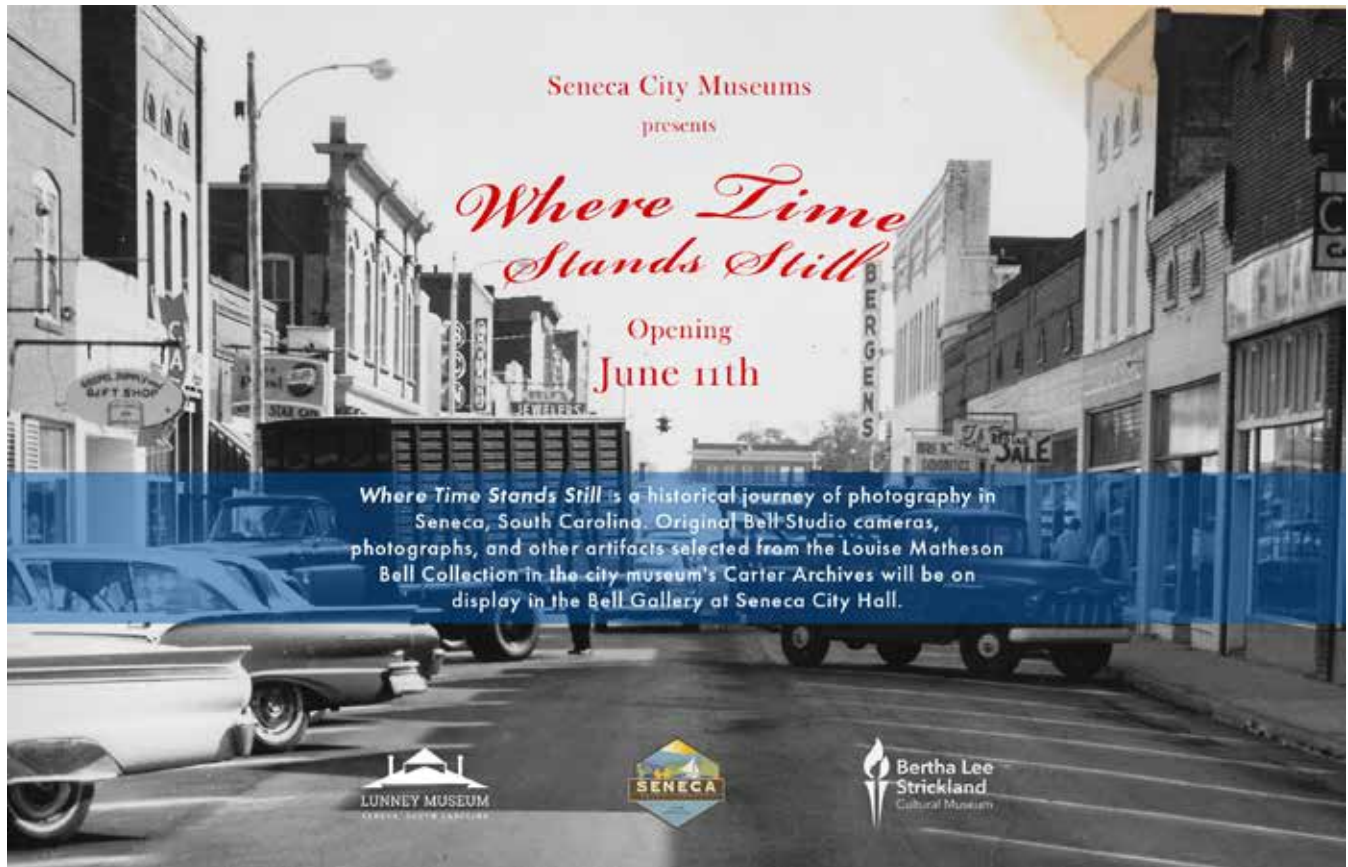
City of Seneca employees worked hard to add fresh touches to the downtown area in preparation for Seneca Fest. Seneca Fest was held May 23 - 25.
