SENECA ADVENTURE TRAIL OPENS AT SHAVER RECREATION COMPLEX

The Seneca Adventure Trail, a new option for runners and walkers alike, opened to the public on October 3rd.

The approximately 3-mile trail winds through the woods directly behind Shaver Complex, and encompasses both challenging hills and slopes, as well as flatter and straighter sections of the trail.

City Administrator Scott Moulder said the trail was designed and created to provide a scenic alternative to runners and walkers that would give them access to a different kind of recreation and exercise venue.

“The Adventure Trail allows its users to enjoy the great outdoors on a surface other than asphalt. Walking and staying healthy is just a little more enjoyable when you’re walking through the woods and observing nature at the same time.”

The trail is well-marked with “Adventure Trail” signs and is open to the public from dawn to dusk. Stay tuned for news about city-sponsored trail-running events similar to the City’s successful annual half-marathon and 5K.
