From Ram Cat Alley to Death Valley, getting to Clemson home football games is now a little easier. Alley to the Valley, a program of the City of Seneca, is offering free parking for the game, free CatBus transportation to and from the game, a green area for tailgating at Norton-Thompson Park, and, a large screen for viewing pre-game activities and then, **THE BIG GAME!**

Yep, for those not going to the game, the Green at Norton-Thompson Park on Main Street will be broadcasting the Clemson football game live on the big screen as well. And, one of the best parts - all this is **FREE**.

The City will also offer free RV parking spots at Gignilliat Field with free electrical and water hookups, with dump stations available. The parking RV spots will be available Wednesday through Sunday for those going to the game.
